



Studies, Research and Community Projects Department

The Department mission is to coordinate and organize all research activities conducted by *Fo.Re.S.T.A.S.* in developing European projects and other specific projects. Research activities are conducted with Fo.Re.STAS' Directorate General and Territorial Departments, and/or with other accredited Public Institutions, such as Universities and Research Institutes. All researches operate according to the programs and priorities established by Fo.Re.STAS. Director General.

The mission of Fo.Re.STAS - acronym of Regional Agency for the Development of the Territory and the Environment of Sardinia - was defined by the Regional Law n. 8 of 27 April 2016, and is to pursue the protection and development of the environment and the rural territory of Sardinia through the following activities:

- management of Regione Sardegna and Municipalities of Sardinia forests (about 220,000 hectares)
- protection of forests and the rural landscape
- wildlife protection and reintroduction of extinct or endangered species;
- prevention and fight against forest fires
- Civil protection activities
- management of the regional ecological network
- management of forest nurseries
- certification of forest environmental sustainability
- promotion and development of forest products
- promotion and diffusion of regional historical, cultural and naturalistic values, including environmental education
- technical assistance
- planning and management of the regional hiking network
- management of the regional trails network

The Studies, Research and Community Projects Department is divided into three offices:

Studies and Research Office

- coordination and/or execution of researches funded by Regione Sardegna, the National Government or the European Union
- projects monitoring and control, and transmission of results to the Director of the Department and to Fo.Re.S.T.A.S Director General

- projects monitoring and control and transmission of results to the Director of the Department and to Fo.Re.S.T.A.S Director General
- publication of the results on Fo.Re.STAS website and scientific newspapers
